## “Identity Theft” and Utilities

Red flag rules have been mandated by the federal government as part of the Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions Act of 2003 (FACTA). Section 111 of FACTA defines “Identity Theft” as fraud committed using the identifying information of another person. Under the Red Flags Rule, every financial institution and creditor including utilities is required to establish an Identify Theft Prevention Program that includes verifying the identity of each new applicant for service. Please have a notary public complete the acknowledgement section below as part of your application for each new application. This form may be faxed with the application but the original must be mailed and received by AEL&P in Juneau, Alaska, within seven (7) calendar days after the date of new service begins.
